



Preparing for potential litigation with Legal Hold



In today's highly complex business environment, nearly every company will find itself a party to legal proceedings at one time or another. At the point at which legal action is anticipated, companies will need to place a legal hold on all forms of relevant information including archived, current and future electronic documents to avoid evidence spoliation.

Easily comply with Legal Hold requirements

Organizations using Datacastle RED to back up endpoint data have a powerful tool that allows them to comply with Legal Hold requirements. Once a litigation notice has been received, administrators can place relevant devices on Legal Hold.

This ensures that all data backed up by these devices in the past, present and future remains in the Vault until the device is removed from Legal Hold. End users are not notified that their device is on Legal Hold and they are not able to delete any of their data from the Datacastle RED Vault.

This new Datacastle RED capability provides organizations with an easy and unobtrusive way to comply with Legal Hold requirements.

Key features

- **Batch restores to a target location:** Administrators can do batch restores to a target like a file server, a local hard drive or a network attached storage location for recovery. This saves time as data from multiple user devices can be moved at once rather than one-at-a-time
- **Data cannot be deleted:** Devices will continue backing data up to the Datacastle RED Vault but data cannot be deleted while the device is on Legal Hold
- **No limit on versions:** An unlimited number of versions can be retained in the Vault
- **Centralized management:** The process is centrally managed via the Datacastle Administrator Console and it takes seconds to put a device on Legal Hold.
- **Supports e-Discovery:** Datacastle RED Legal Hold supports the EDRM standard for e-Discovery
